2009 Subscriptions & Fees

After great deliberation the Board of Directors has set the Membership Subscription Fees, Green & Competition Fees for 2009. With expenses rising & commitments to increase contractor fees in line with CPI in 2009 it has been necessary to increase Membership subscriptions.

The increases have been kept to the minimum level necessary to maintain the high standard of the course that is now expected.

Green and Competition Fees have also been set, with no increase in Member playing fees.

Cart Usage Fees

The increasing level of cart use on the course has resulted in an increase in the cost of course maintenance as well as the need for both increases in & improvements to cart paths.

To assist in meeting costs a fee will now apply for all carts on the course, excluding those housed in the Duntryleague cart sheds. For regular cart users an annual permit is available for \$110. For casual cart users a daily fee of \$20 will apply. Alternatively, carts are available for hire through the Pro-Shop. Members: \$25 (9), \$35 (18), Non-Members: \$30 (9), \$40 (18).

Membership Category Changes

Two significant changes have taken place to the structure of Membership. The first is the removal of Country & Metropolitan Membership categories in lieu of a new "Regional Membership". Access to the discounted Regional Membership category will be available to those residing 100km or more from Orange. The second is the structure of Tennis Membership. From 2009 Duntryleague will affiliate with Tennis NSW & Duntryleague Tennis Membership will include NSW Tennis affiliation. Tennis Membership incorporates Social Membership & entitles Members to discounted court fees.

Duntryleague Tennis Club

2009 will see the re-launch of the Duntryleague Tennis Club, including the Club Competition to be played in April. Women's & Men's singles & doubles as well as mixed doubles categories will be played.

Ladies social play is available on Thursdays & Sundays with Men's social play on Saturdays.

Expressions of interest are sought for a Juniors Competition to commence in 2009.
