Dinner will be held following the presentation of trophies and will be restricted to 150 persons.

Conditions of Entry

Handicap Limit 36

To limit numbers to 300, a handicap limit of 36 will apply.

- Competitions are open to full playing Amateur Members of golf clubs affiliated with WGA and the club recognized by the governing body.
- **Entries to Tournament Secretary by Tuesday 30th September 2008. NO REFUNDS AFTER THIS DATE.**
- WGA handicaps must accompany all entries and WGA handicap cards shown on request. NO temporary handicaps will be accepted.
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to adjust the handicap of any competitor should they deem it advisable.
- Competitors will be drawn and start at times allotted. The Match Committee or such person as the Match Committee may have the power to select a partner for any competitor whose partner is not at the first tee when called at the appointed time.
- In the event of a tie, the decision will be by count-back, except the Orange Cup, which will be a sudden death playoff.
- The decision of the Match Committee on all points of dispute or protest shall be final. Protests should be lodged in writing with the Committee before 5:30pm on the day of dispute.
- The Committee will have the power to alter and make any variations in the conditions or program should they deem it necessary.
- **No competitor shall be eligible to receive more than two trophies, except for special events. Foursomes on Friday 31st—one trophy per person.**
- Motorised transport permitted—bookings for carts to phone the Pro Shop on 02 63624072. Caddies are permitted. Mobile phones to be turned off under WGA conditions.
- All balls won must be collected at the Pro Shop by Friday 31st October 2008.
- **Perpetual Trophies: After presentations trophies must be returned to Officials/Committee as they may no longer be retained by the winners.**
- Dress Regulations: NOT PERMITTED—Brief shorts, singlet tops, body suits, track suit pants and leggings.
- **METAL SPIKES ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
